**“GODS & FLESH”  
original poetry by Mary Ann Larkin  
and Patric Pepper**

“Gods & Flesh” will be the theme of new poems read by Mary Ann Larkin and Patric Pepper on September 4 when they return to the Truro Library for the season’s last Summer Literary Plus evening. “The poems explore the connections between flesh and some of the more unusual forms of the divine,” according to Larkin. Pepper will also read, along the same theme, from Jack Gilbert’s Tough Heaven, published by Pond Road Press, Larkin and Pepper’s literary press. Larkin will read from her new chapbook, Gods and Flesh, published this spring by Plan B Press of Philadelphia, and from some newer poems. Pepper will read from new work as well as poems from his 2005 book Temporary Apprehensions. Both Larkin and Pepper have published widely. Jack Gilbert, a former Pulitzer Prize finalist, won the National Book Critics Circle Award in 2005 for his book Refusing Heaven.
